## Neighborhood Network Grant

Martin Housing Authority (MHA) is one of only two agencies in Tennessee to have been awarded a grant award. MHA will use the \$150,000 award over the next three years to develop and operate a Neighborhood Network Center in its community center located in Martin. This center will link families to education, employment, healthcare and other quality-of-life resources utilizing state of the art computer equipment and other technologies. MHA has partnered with over a dozen local service providers who will donate or discount their services to improve the program's success. This grant will fund a state of the art technology center, provide life skill training, continuing education, job training and career development.
